<u>FULL DAY STUDENTS</u>: From 2:00pm to 5:00pm the students are will be cared for by the teacher/teachers on duty while they await your arrival. Students collected after 5pm will be taken to the Waiting Class – which is located near the Preschool Terrace in the Music & Movement Room, 2 staff members are assigned to care for students collected from the waiting class. ALL parents that suspect that they may arrive later than 5:30pm must notify the school office before 5:30pm and these parents will need to pay a R100 late collection fee, valid reason is required. This fee will be invoiced on the next working day and must be paid immediately, to enable us to compensate the necessary inconvenienced staff for the overtime worked.

<u>ALL STUDENTS</u>: Live & Learn Academy is closed on public holidays and 1 month in December/January depending on the dates and holidays each year. The rest of the year, the centre remains open with a few exceptions. We will notify you each year of the exact dates that we are closed. Please note that we reserve the right to change these dates, but these changes will be provided to you in writing. We also allow for a few long weekends during the year where we would be closed on the Monday/Friday that falls on the weekend of a Public Holiday, to allow our hard-working staff some time to rest and for them to complete staff training annually which is a necessity.

TUITION & FEES: TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TUITION:

The student tuition is calculated for the full academic year, which includes everything listed in the inclusion table. **Tuition is payable in advance for the period selected.** Monthly Option fees are due on or before the 1st of the month.

A Sibling discount of R300 monthly applies to the tuition fee, excluding siblings in the Bambino Group and Half Day students. An annual increase of approximately 10% will apply and the exact amount will be provided on the following academic year's reenrolment form. We make every effort to keep our increases to a minimum.

LATE PAYMENTS:

All invoiced fees are due on or before the 1st of the month, in advance. Fees not reflected in our account on the 3rd of the month will incur a 5% penalty on the total outstanding balance invoiced monthly. Monthly invoices are issued on the 27th of the month for the upcoming tuition month.

ANNUAL REGISTRATION/ENROLMENT ADMIN FEE:

An annual registration fee is applicable per family, and not per student. This fee is due before applications will be processed. The registration fee is NON-REFUNDABLE. This fee is required to secure your child's placement in a class for 2025.

DEPOSIT FEE:

A Deposit fee equal to 1 month's tuition is applicable. This deposit is used as payment for the notice period, should it apply. Therefore, should you give your calendar months' notice, the deposit will settle the month's tuition. This Deposit fee will be balanced every year to accommodate the annual increase. You will be invoiced the difference upon re-enrolment for the next academic year. The Deposit fee is due to be paid together with the first month's tuition fee. This can be paid over 3 months upon arrangement with the accounts department. Upon reenrolment, this fee is due by no later than October.

FULL DAY OR HALF DAY PROGRAM:

Should a parent wish to change programs during the academic year, a calendar months' notice is required. Therefore, the tuition fee will be changed on the invoices for the payment period thereafter.

NOTICE:

A FULL Calendar months' notice is due, given before the 1st of the month in writing.

This must be emailed to manager@liveandlearn.co.za. Notice may not be given for the months of September, October & November. Should notice be given during this time, the parents will be liable for the tuition fees due for this period.

TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS:

There are several options available for the payment of tuition and they are detailed on the next page. The total cost of tuition is calculated for an academic year and divided into 12 monthly payments. This is the default deposit amount due, which is equal to 1 month's tuition. This tuition includes the services offered from our opening day in January to our closing day in December. Therefore, the monthly tuition is a 12-part payment of an annual tuition fee and should not be viewed as payment for the services rendered in a month. The 12 x payment option is the standard option and is due on the 1st of every month January to December. The 11 x payment option is for parents who would prefer to not have a payment in December and therefore the annual tuition is divided into 11 payments which are payable on the 1st of the month from January to November. The 2 x annual payment option is a discounted annual tuition fee, divided into 2 payments which are payable before the 1st of January for Semester 1 and on the 1st of June for Semester 2 of the academic year. The 1 x annual payment is a further discounted annual tuition fee, which is payable before the 1st of January and is payment for the full academic year.
