TUITION & FEES: TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TUITION:

The student tuition is calculated for the full academic year, which includes everything listed in the inclusion table. **Tuition is payable in advance for the period selected.** Monthly Option fees are due on or before the 1st of the month.

LATE PAYMENTS:

All invoiced fees are due on or before the 1st of the month, in advance. Fees not reflected in our account on the 3rd of the month will incur a 5% penalty on the total outstanding balance invoiced monthly. Monthly invoices are issued on the 27th of the month for the upcoming tuition month.

ANNUAL REGISTRATION/ENROLMENT ADMIN FEE:

An annual registration fee is applicable per family, and not per student. This fee is due before applications will be processed. The registration fee is NON-REFUNDABLE. This fee is required to secure your child's placement in a class for 2025.

STATIONERY & PRINTING FEE:

An annual stationery and printing fee per student is required and due upon enrolment or in the case of re-enrolment for the next academic year, the fee is due by October of the current year. This fee covers the printing of all educational material, stationery, educational equipment, art supplies & craft supplies. For normal usage of consumable items, the items will be replenished by the school when needed. If a student misplaces or damages stationery, equipment, or educational material, the parent will be required to replace these items upon request. Stationery will not be supplied or ordered without the payment of this fee being made as mentioned above.

DEPOSIT FEE:

A Deposit fee equal to 1 month's tuition is applicable. This deposit is used as payment for the notice period, should it apply. Therefore, should you give your calendar months' notice, the deposit will settle the month's tuition. This Deposit fee will be balanced every year to accommodate the annual increase. You will be invoiced the difference upon reenrolment for the next academic year. The Deposit fee is due to be paid together with the first month's tuition fee. This can be paid over 3 months upon arrangement with the accounts department. Upon reenrolment, this fee is due by no later than October.

AFTER-CARE PROGRAM:

An after-care program is available Mondays to Thursdays from 3pm to 5:30pm and on Fridays from 2pm to 5:30pm. Students must be enrolled into the after-care program when registering or re-enrolling. The After-care fee is payable together with the tuition and on the same payment option selected for tuition. Should a parent wish to deregister their child from the after-care program, a calendar months' notice is required. Therefore, the after-care fee will be removed from the invoices for the payment period thereafter.

NOTICE:

A FULL Calendar months' notice is due, given before the 1st of the month in writing.

This must be emailed to manager@liveandlearn.co.za. Notice may not be given for the months of September, October & November. Should notice be given during this time, the parents will be liable for the tuition fees due for this period.

DISCOUNTS:

A Sibling discount of R300 monthly applies to the tuition fee, excluding siblings in the Bambino Group and Half Day in Preschool.

ANNUAL FEE INCREASE:

An annual increase of approximately 10% will apply and the exact amount will be provided on the following academic year's re-enrolment form. We make every effort to keep our increases to a minimum.

TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS:

There are several options available for the payment of tuition and they are detailed on the next page. The total cost of tuition is calculated for an academic year and divided into 12 monthly payments. This is the default deposit amount due, which is equal to 1 month's tuition. This tuition includes the services offered from our opening day in January to our closing day in December. Therefore, the monthly tuition is a 12-part payment of an annual tuition fee and should not be viewed as payment for the services rendered in a month. The 12 x payment option is the standard option and is due on the 1st of every month January to December. The 11 x payment option is for parents who would prefer to not have a payment in December and therefore the annual tuition is divided into 11 payments which are payable on the 1st of the month from January to November. The 2 x annual payment option is a discounted annual tuition fee, divided into 2 payments which are payable before the 1st of January for Semester 1 and on the 1st of June for Semester 2 of the academic year. The 1 x annual payment is a further discounted annual tuition fee, which is payable before the 1st of January and is payment for the full academic year.
